

OCTOBER 2021 KENDALL VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

The October board meeting of the Village of Kendall was brought to order on October 11, 2021 at 5:30 pm by President Martin along with board members M Prell, W Bunk, and D Larson, A Keenan, and M Crneckiy present with L Wyttenbach arriving late at 5:35 pm. Also present was public works director D Gruen and 5 visitors.

*Motion by Wyttenbach, 2nd by Prell to accept the September regular meeting minutes. MC

*Motion by Bunk 2nd by Larson to accept the September Bills. MC

*Motion by Keenan 2nd by Crneckiy to accept the September Treasurers report. MC

*Clerk's report was given.

*Public Works' report was given.

*Public Comments: Gail Schoenfeld – how do we clean up this town? Something needs to be done. Board discussed granting the building zoning administrator the authority to issue citations for ordinance violations in the absence of law enforcement.

*Senator Marklein was present and spoke about the state budget. Keenan asked about the tax base the village is losing with the FEMA buyout properties. Martin asked about broadband expansion into rural areas.

*Motion by Keenan 2nd by Wyttenbach to accept the bid offered by Dan Wildes to purchase the property located at 215 Glendale Rd for \$2300 with a 3-year land contract with the conditions outlined in the original bid posting. MC

*Motion by Prell, 2nd by Bunk to continue to heat the park shelters winter 2021-22. MC

*Motion by Prell 2nd by Larson to accept the bid for the new counter for the village clerk's office for \$3,496.47 from Environments with Martin donating his \$1,000 annual president salary towards the cost of the new counter and the remaining \$2,496.47 to be divided equally between the village general fund, sewer and water funds. MC

*Resolution 2021-07 to use previous years unused tax levy was brought forth by Wyttenbach and was passed to with a vote of 7 ayes and 0 nays. RP

*Motion by Bunk, 2nd by Keenan to go into closed session. MC

*Motion by Wyttenbach, 2nd by Keenan to allow the library assistant to work extra hour per week from 12 to 13 hours and her wage will be discussed with the rest of the village employee wages. MC

*Motion by Crneckiy, 2nd by Bunk to go out of closed session. MC

*Motion by Bunk, 2nd by Keenan to adjourn. MC
